WI-FI

Wi-Fi is available at the Hotel, at no additional cost.

ACCOMMODATIONS & BREAKFAST AT THE YWCA Hotel:

There are various types of rooms available at the YWCA Hotel. The room types & rates available are as follows, in each case not including taxes:

- 1) Double bed with private bath (for one or two people): \$84/night
- 2) Two single beds with hall bath (per person): \$39.50/night
- 3) Three single beds with hall bath (per person): \$30/night

Rooms at these rates can only be booked until October 21st. We do not have a large number of rooms available to us. Once the maximum number of rooms for a specific room type has been booked, that room type will be taken off of the registration site. For those who wish to stay over on Saturday night, there are a few rooms reserved – the only type available that night is #1, above. Except for those booking a single room, we reserve the right to rearrange accommodations as needed to ensure full rooms. This could mean an adjustment to the rate.

If you wish to have a roommate(s), please state this in your registration form with the person's name or an indication that you are seeking one, and we can likely find one.

Breakfast: There are shared kitchens at the Y. We will have simple, make-your-own breakfasts including oatmeal, toast, nut butters, fruit, coffee, & tea for \$5/ day.

TRAVEL

Car-pooling:

Some individuals from Victoria & other nearby regions may be car-pooling to the Conference; please indicate on the registration form if you are interested in joining or starting a car-pool.

Air Transportation, & Ground Transportation from the Airport: The Vancouver International Airport is about a 25-minute Skytrain trip to the Vancouver City Centre stop, and then a 7-minute walk from this stop to the Y. The fare is \$9 per direction.

Other ground transportation:

There is both bus and train service to Vancouver.

TRANSPORTATION SUBSIDY

Worker Co-op Members: A transportation subsidy is available to CWCF worker co-op members who choose to fly (and who come from outside of a 1/2-day driving time/radius into Vancouver) to assist them to attend. This amount will be approximately 1/2 the seatsale airfare cost. If you require this subsidy, please indicate this on your registration form. Please book early, as the individual subsidy, and possibly the number of subsidies, will be limited.

CWCF will also subsidize the cost of car-pooling from outside the area, upon request.

PARKING: Limited parking is available on site for \$15/ night plus tax. Secure, underground bike parking is free.
