



2018 Conference Registration Information

The Conference starts in the morning of Thursday, November 1st and runs until mid-afternoon on Saturday, November 3rd. On Thursday during the day, there are Intensive Sessions with two different options:

- 1) For worker co-op members, there is a Worker Co-op Financial Management Intensive.
- 2) For others, there is a CoopZone-hosted Intensive day.

Registration Fees:

The registration fee covers access to all on-site Conference activities and lunches on Friday and Saturday.

Not included are accommodations, other meals, and tax. We will make recommendations for Thursday lunch, and dinners - including for special diets, low-budget options, etc.

Conference fees for members are offered on a cost-recovery basis. For those members who cannot easily afford this fee, we offer a subsidized rate, upon request. It is also intended for those members sending a second or third (etc.) participant.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Standard rooms with two Queen-sized beds are available at a rate of \$105/ night (includes breakfast). We may be able to make billet spaces available, provided by worker co-op members in the area. If you are interested, please indicate this on your registration form. There are also other hotels nearby.

Air Transportation & Ground Transportation from the Airport:

Our airport/bus depot is on the NW edge of town but is only a 15 min drive to downtown.

To travel downtown by bus take the number 15 Winnipeg Transit (Sargent-Mountain -Inkster Park via Church) bus to Portage Avenue at Fort St. It will be about an 8 minute walk to the hotel or you can take a transfer to the #19 (Marion-Logan-Notre Dame and get off at Southbound Main at St. Mary Avenue. There will only be a 2 minute walk this way. The cash fare is \$2.95. There are also taxis. Parking at the hotel for overnight guests is \$10/night. For those not staying at the hotel, daytime parking charge is \$15/day.

TRANSPORTATION SUBSIDY

Worker Co-op Members: A transportation subsidy is available to CWCF worker co-op members to assist them to attend. This amount will be approximately 1/2 the seatsale airfare cost. If you require this subsidy, please indicate this on your registration form. Please book early, as the individual subsidy, and possibly the number of subsidies, will be limited.

CWCF will also subsidize the cost of car-pooling from outside the area, upon request.
