

"The form of association, however, which if mankind continues to improve, must be expected in the end, to predominate is not that which can exist between a capitalist as chief and work-people without a voice in the management,




Managing the Co-operative Difference

John Stuart Mill, Principles of Political Economy (1848)


Of people, structures and action

But structures can nurture good and evil action.






Without co-operatives climate change will accelerate.


Transition Cost: Reletively Low


