Paul also served as Chair of the Justice Committee and Chair of the Foreign Affairs Sub-Committee on Human Rights.

While serving as Secretary of State for Physical Activity and Sport, Paul promoted and attended many national and international sporting events, including the Salt Lake City Olympic Games and the Commonwealth Games in Manchester. Paul also attended the Arctic Winter Games in Iqaluit and the North American Aboriginal Games in Winnipeg.
